

Hyperion Biosystems - Privacy Policy

Hyperion Biosystems ("Hyperion," "we," "us," or "our") operates the Halo website (the "Site"). This policy explains what information we collect through the Site, how we use it, and the choices you have. This Site is an informational product website; it is not used to collect health information or to provide diagnostic services.

1. Information we collect

Information you provide. When you submit our contact form, we collect the details you enter - your name, work email, organization, and message. We use this only to respond to your inquiry.

Information collected automatically. We use privacy-preserving, aggregate analytics to understand general Site usage - such as pages viewed, approximate region (derived from IP, not stored), referring source, and device or browser type. This data is aggregated and is not used to identify you.

We do not use advertising trackers, third-party marketing pixels, session-recording tools, or cross-site tracking.

2. Cookies and similar technologies

We do not use cookies for advertising or cross-site tracking. Our analytics are configured to run without cookies and without storing personal identifiers. If any strictly necessary cookies are used for core Site functionality, they do not track you across other websites. Because we do not sell or share personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising, we honor browser-based opt-out signals (such as Global Privacy Control) where applicable.

3. How we use information

- * To respond to inquiries and communicate with you about Halo.
- * To operate, maintain, secure, and improve the Site.
- * To comply with legal obligations and enforce our terms.

4. How we share information

We do not sell or rent your personal information. We share it only with service providers that help us operate the Site, under agreements that limit their use of the data - or when required by law or to protect our legal rights.

5. Data retention

We keep contact-form submissions for as long as needed to address your inquiry and for a reasonable period afterward, unless a longer period is required by law.

6. Your privacy rights

Depending on where you live, you may have rights to access, correct, delete, or restrict the use of your personal information, and to opt out of the “sale” or “sharing” of personal information (we do not sell or share it). California residents have these rights under the CCPA/CPRA; residents of other jurisdictions may have similar rights.

7. Data security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect the information we collect. No method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.
